

## EAST RENFREWSHIRE GOLF CLUB'S CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/CARERS

As a parent/carer of a junior member you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct.

You should:

- encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- discourage unfair play and arguing with club staff/officials.
- help your child to recognise good performance and effort, not just results.
- encourage your child to recognise fair play and applaud good performances.
- publicly accept officials' judgements.
- support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their golf.
- notify the Junior Organiser if you will not be attending or going to be late for a coaching session/competition.
- ensure that coaches are made aware of any pre-existing medical conditions your child has.
- ensure that all correspondence and consent forms are returned by the due date.
- ensure that your child is dropped off and picked up safely after each session.
