AVOID

- getting too close to play - keep to the rough. If you are supporting a player, you should remain a respectful distance from other players.
- giving players advice.
- getting involved with rulings.
- using inappropriate language.
- interacting with players or officials on course unless directed.
- Verbally or physically abusing anyone.
- behaving in a disrespectful manner towards others both in person and with all communications.
- responding negatively to a bad result.
